



# URGENT PRODUCT DEFECT CORRECTION

Haleon is issuing a Product Defect Correction for the above-mentioned batches of PANADOL CHILDREN 1 MONTH – 1 YEAR paracetamol 100 mg/mL oral liquid bottle (which is used for the temporary relief of pain and fever) due to difficulties that may be experienced when using the supplied dosing syringe.

**There is no concern around the liquid medicine itself. The component impacted is the dosing syringe.**

The dosing syringe in the affected batches may experience stiffness impacting the ability to control the delivery of the medicine to babies which may pose a risk of choking in babies.

No other batches of this product, or other Panadol Children products, are affected.

If you have PANADOL CHILDREN 1 MONTH – 1 YEAR paracetamol 100 mg/mL oral liquid bottle from the batches listed above, dispose of the supplied syringe, and seek an alternative dosing syringe from your pharmacy. Dosing syringes printed with “Panadol” are not impacted.
